EMERGENCY AID FOR NATURAL DISASTERS

The climate change-intensified natural disasters of 2017 have laid bare the federal government's current response as both politicized and racist. How would you identify and legislatively fix underlying structural flaws in federal disaster relief and preparedness funding to ensure more timely, equitable, and effective federal responses to future events? (No more than 250 words)

Federal disaster relief should not depend on the economic importance of the affected area. Providing aid to people in need should not depend on the whims of a temperamental president. I support legislation that gives Congress the power to declare a natural disaster when the executive branch fails to do so in a timely manner, and Congress should then be able to order FEMA to provide the necessary federal assistance, including temporary housing, emergency health care services, and infrastructural rebuilding (electricity grids, communication lines, etc.). Once the immediate emergency needs are taken care of, Congress should be able to authorize the expenditure of funds to provide assistance to families for both the short-term and long-term until recovery is complete. Regarding health care for victims of natural disasters, I believe that provisions should be made in the law to ensure that these

victims are automatically enrolled in Medicaid or Medicare to ensure that they receive the necessary medical care. I would also advocate for Congress to have the power to waive the Jones Act so that non-American ships can help in the recovery process (Trump's failure to waive the Jones Act contributed to the crisis in Puerto Rico following Hurricane Maria).

Corporate Rule

Big corporations and banks dominant our political process, spending billions to lobby for programs against the public interest, and to privatize public services for profit. This erodes the middle class, destroys vital services, increases poverty, and undermines our nation. Congress must work to return our government to the people, improve services, stand up to corporate lobbyists, and stop the privatization of public services. We need a constitutional amendment to establish that corporations are not people and that money does not equal speech.

- Your campaign plan with some *detail*

My plan is to have face-to-face interactions with as many voters as possible. In the urban area, increasing voter turnout is vital to winning in 2018, and we have organized weekly Saturday and Sunday blockwalking events in order to make this happen. In the rural areas, it's important to show that the candidate cares about their unique issues, so I emphasize hyper-local issues that transcend partisan politics (for example, corporate monopolization by AT&T precludes high-speed internet in Lampasas, and people care about this issue regardless of party affiliation). We have a Rural Outreach Coordinator spear-heading a neighbor-to-neighbor mailer campaign (personalized postcards written by volunteers in the rural districts) and organizing blockwalking events in two key precincts in Bell County. During the general election, I also plan to hold as many meet-and-greet events as possible in the rural areas in order to reach out to rural voters.

- Your capacity to raise the necessary capital to fund the campaign,

Our people-powered campaign has raised over \$100,000 without taking a cent of corporate PAC money. That's more than all of Roger Williams' past opponents combined. Also, many people have told me that they are waiting until after the primary to make a financial contribution, and there appears to be the potential to raise \$750,000 to \$1 million in the general election. The key will be convincing people that District 25 is winnable, and the numbers

show that if we have turnout consistent with a presidential election year, while the Republicans have turnout more consistent with a midterm year, we will win.

Both our fundraising (numerous small-dollar donations) and endorsements (we've swept the endorsements among organizations with a formal endorsement process who have endorsed in our race) show our grassroots support, along with significant volunteer and social media engagement (over 4,000 Facebook followers and over 2,500 Twitter followers).


