My plan is to run as an unabashed progressive who is campaigning on social and economic justice for all. This message is resonating with voters in the 39th district. I have a field plan in place that relies on contacting every Democratic and non-party preference voter in the district that has voted recently in order to ask directly through their vote - either by means of texting them, calling them, or going straight to their door. The voter rich areas of Fullerton, La Habra, and Chino Hills will be especially important for the campaign to target.

- **Your capacity to raise the necessary capital to fund the campaign,**

I have been fortunate to be able to put more than \$2 million into my campaign because I do not want to spend time on the phone asking for contributions, I want to spend it out in the community meeting with voters and hearing about what is important to them. This has allowed me to fund a fully staffed campaign that has hit the ground running since we announced to bring an inclusive message of social and economic justice to the voters through every means possible - voter contact, online ads, direct mail, and television.

- **grassroots support**

After more than 20,000 doors knocked, thousands of calls made, and tens of thousands of texts sent, all carried out by hundreds of volunteers, my campaign has identified an impressive 8,000 strong supporters. Our strong ground game has lead to the endorsements of prominent local activists such as Julio Castenada, Leon Cisneros, and Jose Trinidad Castenada. This, along with a progressive platform, has earned the campaign the support the local Our Revolution Orange County chapter, as well as the national Our Revolution organization.
