### **EMERGENCY AID FOR NATURAL DISASTERS**

The climate change-intensified natural disasters of 2017 have laid bare the federal government's current response as both politicized and racist. How would you identify and legislatively fix underlying structural flaws in federal disaster relief and preparedness funding to ensure more timely, equitable, a effective federal responses to future events? (No more than 250 words)

What's happening in Puerto Rico is outrageous. But this reflects the priorities of Congress and the Trump administration. How can a progressive Congress ensure more equitable federal disaster relief, even when there is a reactionary Congress and Executive Branch in power? One mechanism might be by legislatively extending anti-discrimination protections (such as contained in the Civil Rights Act), with explicit judicial review, to the recipients of federal disaster relief, whether from FEMA or the SBA, the Department of Agriculture or other agencies that administer such relief.

I would support hearings and the creation of an independent committee or task force designated with researching the causes behind the lack of federal response in Puerto Rico and potential solutions to ensure a fairer set of responses going forward.

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*We are incredibly proud of the grassroots, people-powered campaign we are running. Our campaign is centered around community engagement and outreach. We were the first campaign in CA-45 to start knocking on doors last September, and since then, we have knocked 15,000 doors. We are building neighborhood teams of volunteers and attending community events at least 5 nights a week.*

*We are also working extensively to reach populations of the district who have long been ignored. The AAPI community here is a significant portion of the population (25%), but has not been engaged by a campaign in a meaningful way in a long time. As the only Asian American in the race, we are sensing that base to be very excited and enthusiastic about our campaign.*

*Aside from our field program, we are also engaging in more traditional tactics including television ads, targeted mailings and digital communications.*

- Your capacity to raise the necessary capital to fund the campaign,

*I've been able to draw a lot of support from my friends, family, and former classmates from Harvard Law School and Penn. My professional finance team works around the clock to make sure we are working every channel possible - from the larger contributions to the grassroots donors giving whatever they can to help us make our goals. I'm also proud to have received the most campaign donations from inside the district of any candidate in reportable funds.*


