The climate change-intensified natural disasters of 2017 have laid bare the federal government's current response as both politicized and racist. How would you identify and legislatively fix underlying structural flaws in federal disaster relief and preparedness funding to ensure more timely, equitable, a effective federal responses to future events? I am very concerned about the federal government's woefully insufficient disaster response after Hurricanes Harvey, Maria and Irma. The suffering of the people in those communities was unimaginable. Natural disasters often expose underlying problems long ignored, like Hurricane Harvey and Houston's long standing water management issues, Hurricane Katrina and the deep poverty and inequality within New Orleans, and Superstorm Sandy and how we construct infrastructure to be resilient. While at the White House as a Senior Technology Advisor, I worked in the aftermath of Hurricane Sandy using Twitter to identify which gas stations had fuel. Technology
