The climate change-intensified natural disasters of 2017 have laid bare the federal government’s current response as both politicized and racist. How would you identify and legislatively fix underlying structural flaws in federal disaster relief and preparedness funding to ensure more timely, equitable, a effective federal responses to future events? We need to guarantee that Americans receive the same level of resources and quality of response to a natural disaster regardless of what US state or territory they live in. I would support legislation that guarantees disaster response parity and empowers FEMA to respond immediately to disasters based on the opinions of non-partisan experts and career staff at the agency. I would also support funding to preemptively equip vulnerable municipalities with infrastructure improvements to mitigate natural disasters before they start. Lastly, I would increase tax credits and incentives to upgrade low-income housing to provide better protection from increasingly more frequent and intense weather events and natural disasters.

- Your campaign plan with some *detail*

The primary focus of our campaign plan is an investment in field organizing. My campaign is managed by one of the most active organizers in WI-01 over the last five years and it also includes the Field Director of the 2012 Walker Recall that knocked over 1 million doors.

We aren't going to raise even close to what Paul Ryan can, so our focus will be on talking about our positive, progressive message with voters face-to-face wherever they are.

We are a digital-first campaign and will focus on targeted digital media over traditional TV ads.

- Your capacity to raise the necessary capital to fund the campaign,

I have raised over \$750,000 to date and I am on pace to raise over \$2 million by our August 14th Primary. Our average donation is just over \$20. Unlike my primary opponent, who was handpicked and backed by establishment groups since Day 1, I have built my organically campaign from the ground up with small dollar donors from across the country. When I win the August 14th Primary and beat Paul Ryan in November, I will be uniquely positioned to be an independent progressive voice for Wisconsin and the country who is un beholden to DC insiders.
