The first step in solving this problem, is correctly identifying it: Disaster Capitalism. We need to remedy this by replacing these market-solution-loving politicians with true progressives who will loudly and proudly stand up for and defend the public sector’s much needed role in addressing not only natural disasters, but the root causes of climate change that are fueling these crises. Pain and suffering should not be an opportunity for private enrichment.

## General

Please provide us with information in the sections provided below, some information about your campaign:

- Your campaign plan with some *detail*

Our campaign plan has evolved a great deal since the race began and we were in a one-on-one race, challenging incumbent Democrat Ruben Kihuen. Now, in a 6-way race for Kihuen's now-open seat, we have a much wider path to victory. With a 6-month lead on our current opponents, we have been able to invest heavily in our ground game. With an expected turnout of 19,000 to 24,000, our win number is between 8,000 and 9,000. We plan to identify a universe of 20,000 1s and 2s before the end of voter registration (May 15), so we can aggressively target and turnout our voters during early voting (May 26 - June 8). We have already identified 15,000 of these voters.

We are the only progressive in the race, and are targeting winning coalition of voters composed of progressives, millennials, military families, healthcare workers, and rural Nevadans. With an time advantage on our opponents, we have already hit the most engaged and likely to vote among registered Democrats, and are now focusing on pick-up opportunities among marginal- and non-voters, especially first time voters, like students, immigrants, and first generation voters. We are the only Democrat campaigning aggressively in the rural counties and have already hit all the rural counties and towns twice, with plans to hit them twice more before June 12.

While we have shown an ability to connect with voters and grassroots donors, far surpassing expectations with our fundraising (all without corporate contributions), we are running a frugal and creative campaign, foregoing typical campaign expenses, like out-of-town consultants and large media buys. Instead, we are investing heavily in a small, but diverse and creative staff, our ground game and field

program, with plans to do highly targeted digital advertising and robo-calls to hit our base of young supporters, and sympathetic older voters, respectively.

By focusing on concrete policy solutions instead of personal relationships, we have been able to find allies in both expected and unexpected places. While Steven Horsford is our co-front runner, he has surprisingly little support among party actors who would otherwise be considered "establishment." There is a universal recognition that while his fundraising efforts will be hard to beat, he's a poor campaigner and weak candidate who puts Nevada Democrats at risk of losing a blue seat in an otherwise strong year. By continuing to be in all the usual places in addition to all the unexpected places on the campaign trail, we have been able to build trust and relationships with key influencers in the local party and community, and slowly but surely position ourselves as an unlikely-but-exciting front runner in this race.

- Your capacity to raise the necessary capital to fund the campaign,

Despite not accepting any corporate PAC contributions, we have been able to raise over \$140,000.00 cycle-to-date from over 6,000 individual contributions. We have recently gotten additional backing from Our Revolution (OR), Progressive Congressional Change Committee (PCCC), National Nurses United (NNU), and the Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers (BAC), who are all either able and willing to donate directly or have the capacity to do direct email fundraising on behalf of the campaign.

In addition to the backing of the organizations and unions listed above, we have the support of Justice Democrats (JD), Brand New Congress (BNC), Demand Universal Healthcare (DUH), The People for Bernie Sanders, and Millennials for Revolution.

My campaign is run primarily by folks with a background in community organizing and activism, and my early local support comes from a coalition of activists and organizations that I was organizing with throughout 2017 in defense of the ACA, the need to move towards Medicare For All, against the GOP Tax Scam, and in defense of DACA and a clean DREAM Act. We continue to grow our grassroots support everyday. We are running an all-volunteer canvassing and phone
